**333/16 FLAG POLES ON PIAZZA**

With work due to start on the Town Hall, access to the existing flag pole will cease, although it will be replaced with a new one in due course. There are, however, no plans to replace the smaller flag holders to the sides of the entrance due to the damage that these cause to the fabric of the building. The possibility of installing two (removable) flagpoles to the sides of the War Memorial has been suggested, which could be used for Town Twinning visits and for Remembrance Sunday as well as any other occasion where the flying of multiple flags is required. This would also provide the opportunity to continue to fly the Union Jack on specified dates, as has been the Council's practice.

Members' views are requested.

**334/16 ADDITIONAL VEHICLE**

A sum of £22,000 was included in this year's budget for the purchase of an additional vehicle, with an additional £2,000 in reserves. Over the last four months, a number of demonstrations have been arranged to ascertain the best provision. An ATV was considered, as were electric vehicles, but the considered view is that the Town Council should purchase an additional tractor, similar to the existing one so that attachments are interchangeable. This addition would

provide both continuity, and flexibility, as the areas for maintenance and the work force grow.

Four companies were approached for quotations, and two have responded (attached)



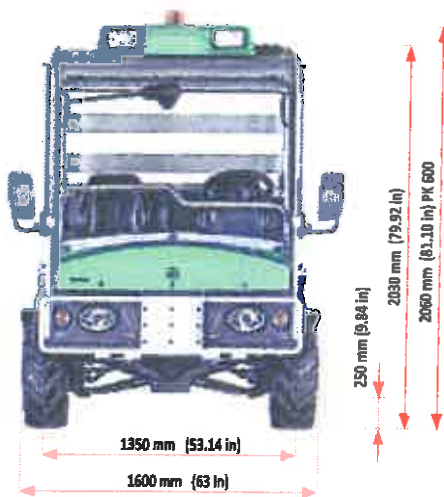

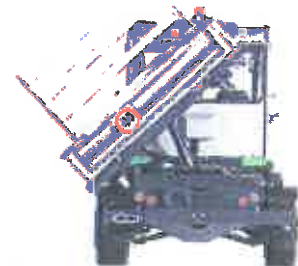
