Sirs,

A43/A422/Oxford Road Roundabout, Brackley

Due to circumstances beyond our control Highways England postponed our last proposed overnight full road closure that was booked for the 11th May. This was due to major road works on the M1 which necessitated the full closure of the M1 to install a new bridge. A final closure of the A43 is still required to allow the final areas of skid resistant surfacing to be laid at the roundabout and its approaches and other finishing works that can only be done when there is no traffic. As these final operations are weather dependant and to avoid the Bank Holiday week our contractor, Colas, has arranged for three overnight closures for the 4th, 5th and 6th June. The closures are as follows:

- The A43 Oxford Road roundabout, the A43 northbound from the Evenley Roundabout to the Oxford Road roundabout, the A43 southbound between Buckingham Road and the Oxford Road roundabout, the A422 between the Banbury Road roundabout and the Oxford Road roundabout and Oxford Road approach to the roundabout will be closed overnight between 20:00-06:00 from Monday 4th June until Wednesday 6th (ie finishing at 06.00 on Thursday 7th June).

If any opportunity arises for reducing the extent of the closures it will be taken but it is dependent upon the weather and how the works progress.

Emergency services (i.e. Fire Brigade, Ambulance and Police as well as Special Forces vehicles) will be allowed access during the works if required to ensure the safety of the general public.

Diversion routes will be fully signed.
