High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. If you have any questions about these works, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inbucksandox.co.uk.

What are we doing?

We have recently been working alongside the carriageways on the A4421 and the A421. We will shortly be constructing highway tie ins which will connect new sections of road and the newly built bridges.

The construction of the new highway will mean some utilities will need to be moved and reinstalled. To be able to carry this out safely a series of weekend closures will happen, on the A421 and the A4421.

These works are essential to safely open the new section of road later this year. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your patience while we complete this work.

When will these works take place?

To reduce our impact on the local area, the A421 and the A4421 will not be closed at the same time. We have coordinated our works so that closures will alternate between the two roads.

The tables on the following pages outline the expected closure dates for the A421 and A4421. The closures, and appropriate diversions will be signposted in advance.

Where possible, we will keep the road open and reduce full road closures to temporary traffic lights. We have installed a traffic lights system to enhance the control of traffic flow through our works sites on the A421 & A4421. These will be in place until autumn 2025.

Signage on the road will indicate the change. Should our teams complete the works ahead of schedule we will work to reopen the roads as soon as possible.

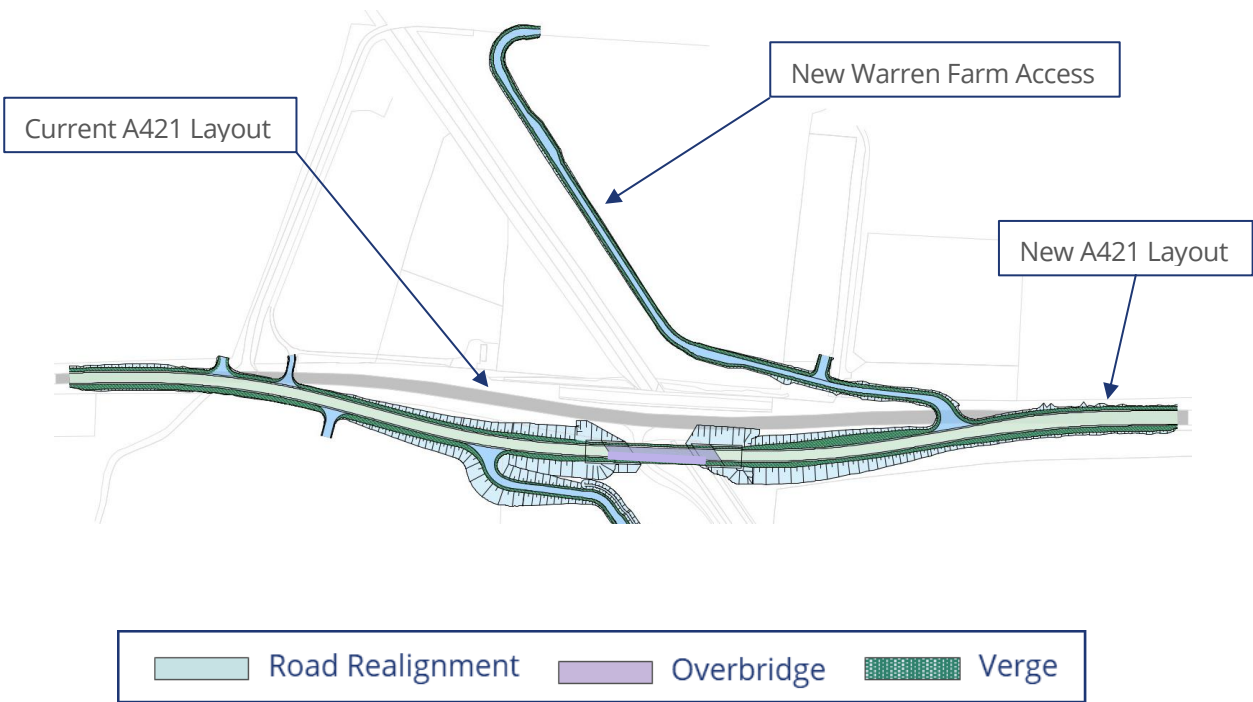

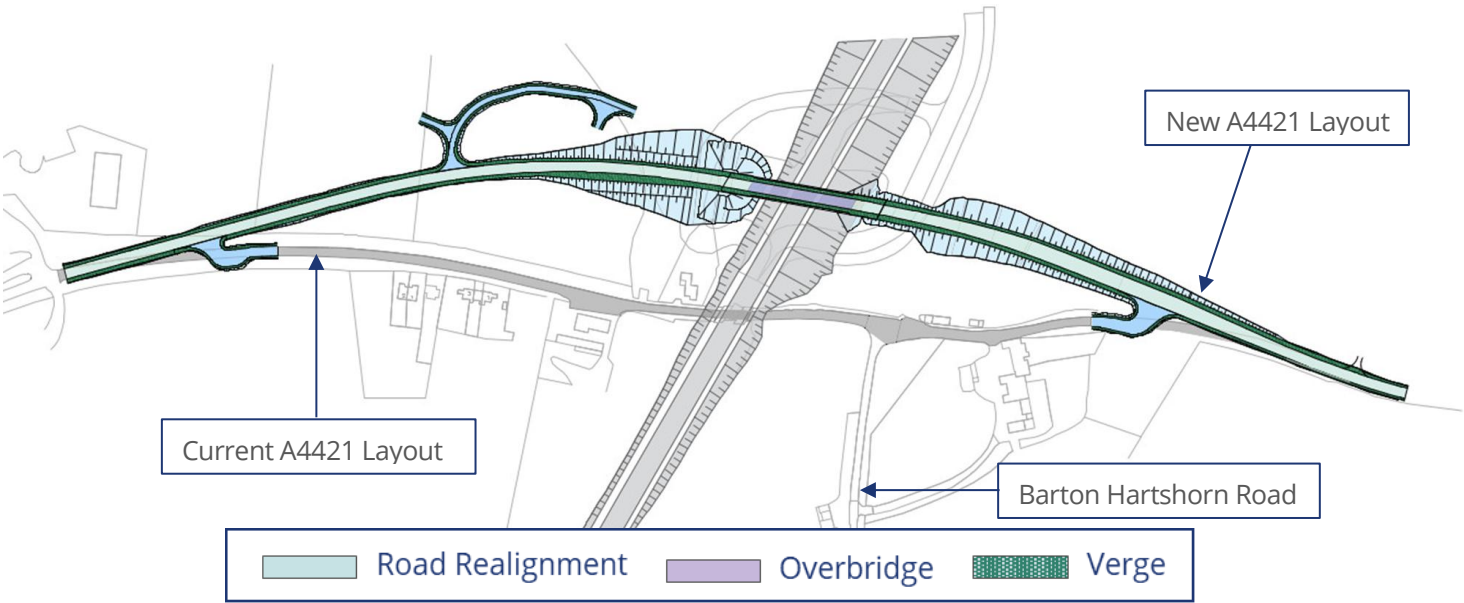

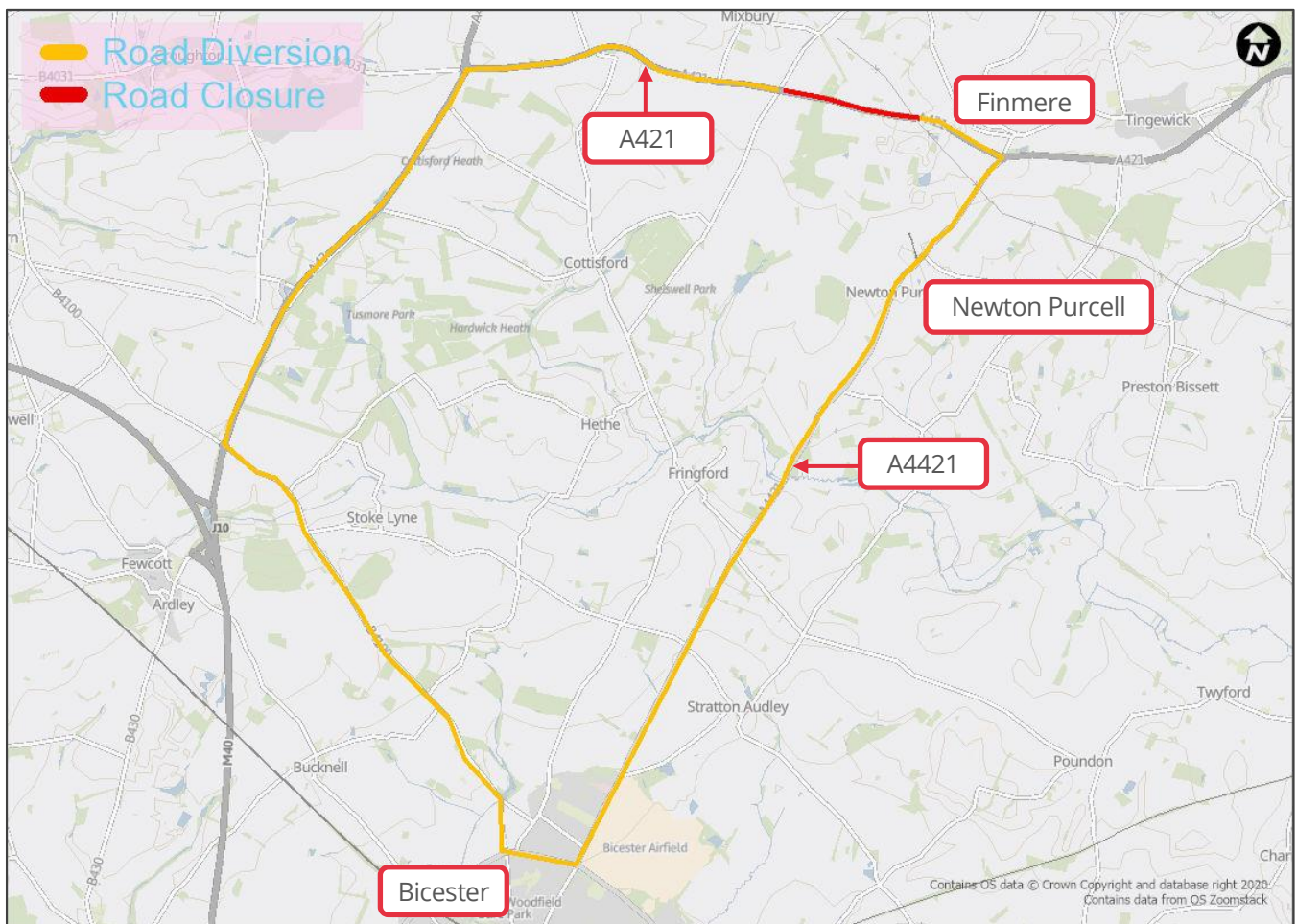

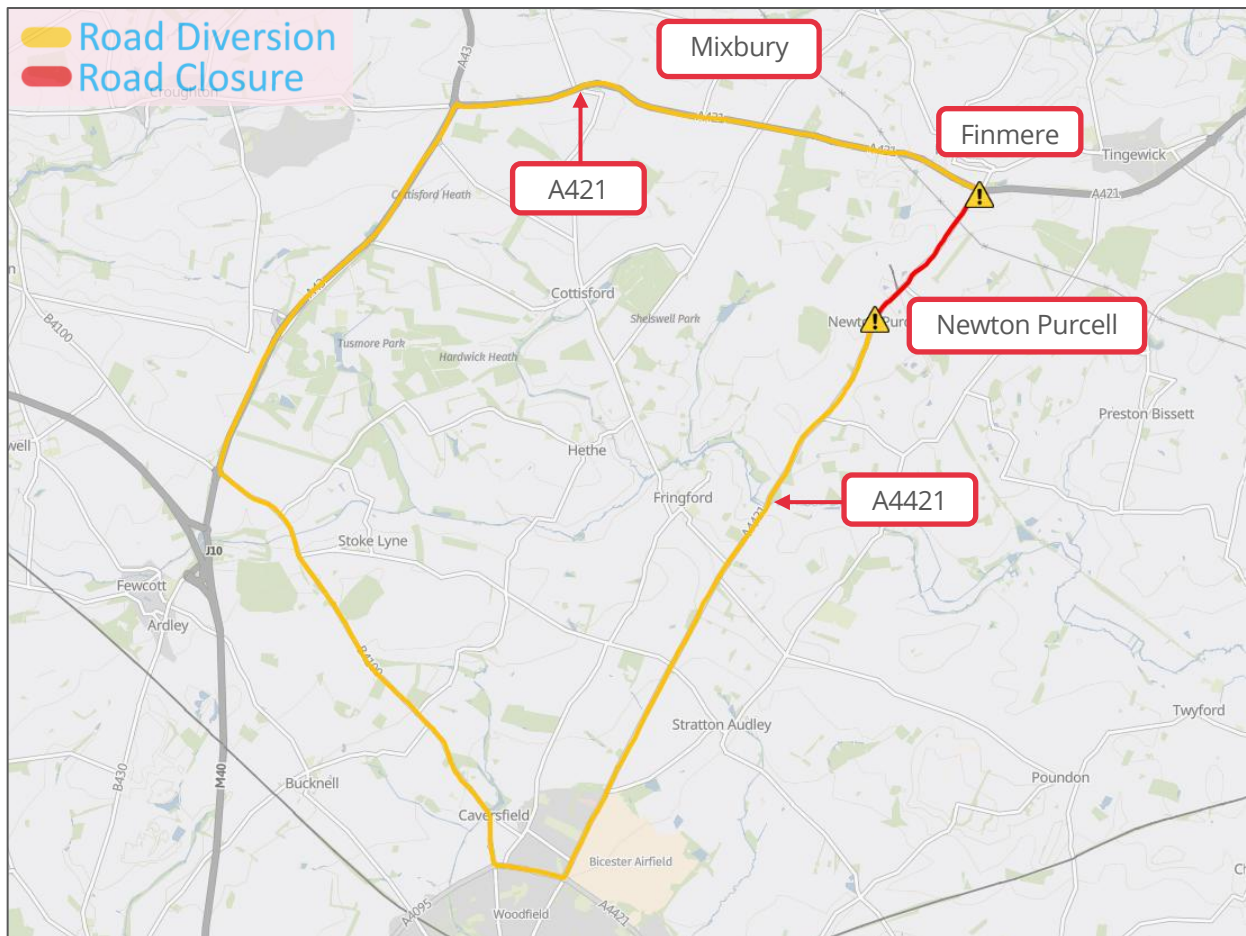
