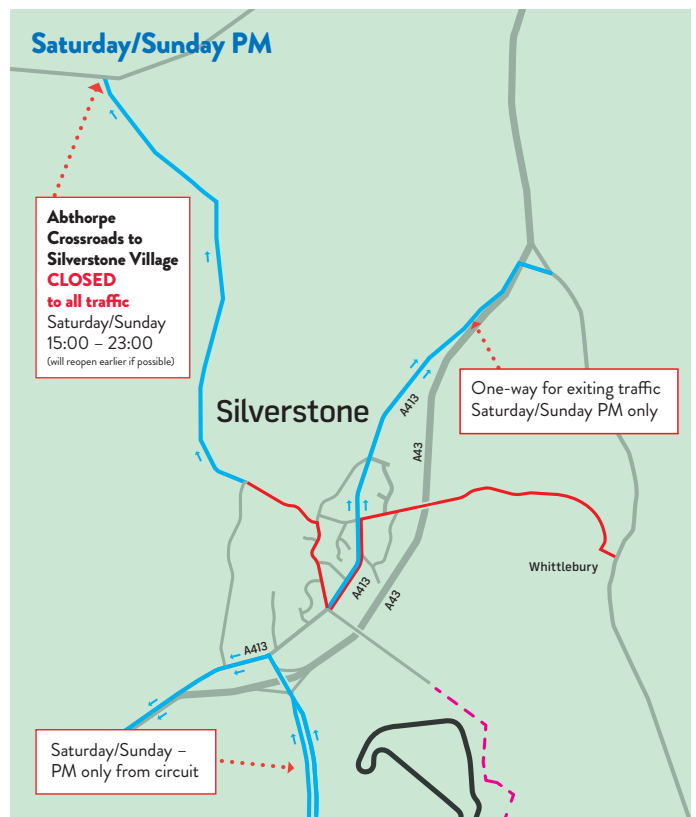
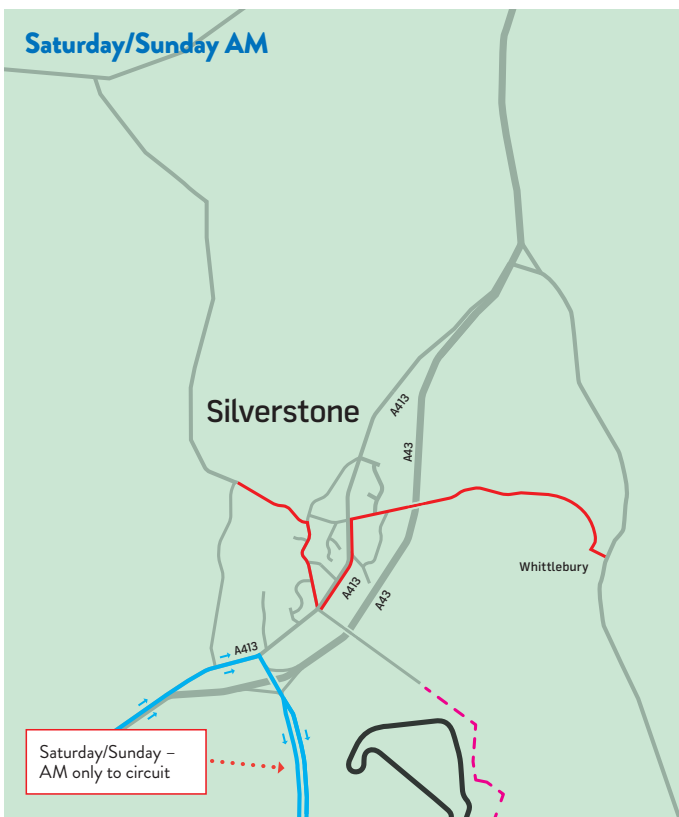
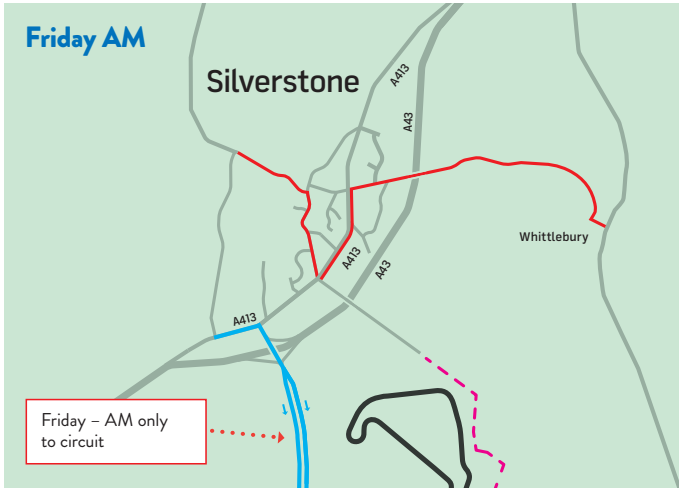
A43 OVERVIEW

KEY One-way system



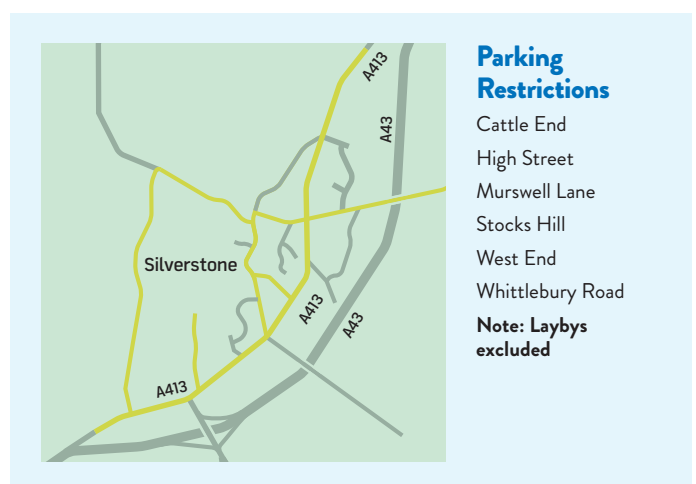

| Note: it is advised to avoid using Dadford Road - Buckingham route due to event traffic. | | | | |
| Saturday/Sunday | To exit village if A43 one-way system is in use: Abthorpe Road, Whittlebury or Dadford Road. Residents are advised to use Abthorpe Road to avoid event traffic. | To exit village if A43 one-way system is operating: use Abthorpe Road, Whittlebury or A413 to Whittlebury (for A43 northbound). | Access into the village if A43 one-way system is in operation: via Abthorpe Road, Whittlebury, A43 Southbound Whittlebury exit, A43 Northbound Silverstone exit (use left hand lane of one-way system). | Access into the village if A43 one-way system is operating: Via Whittlebury Road/ Church Way. |

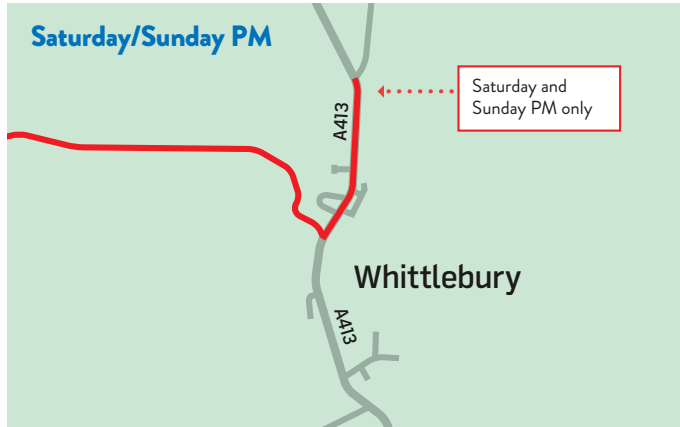

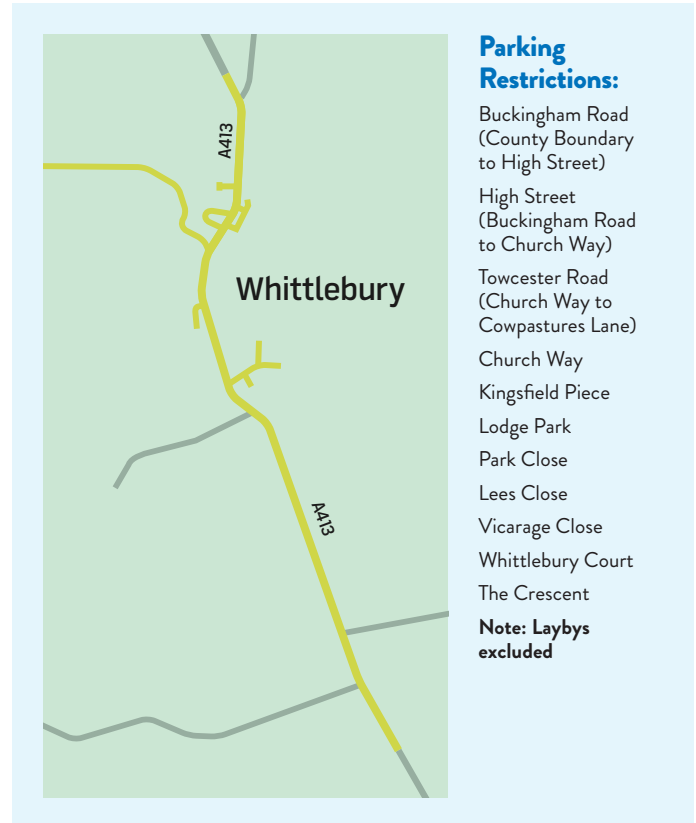

Getting in and out of Whittlebury village:

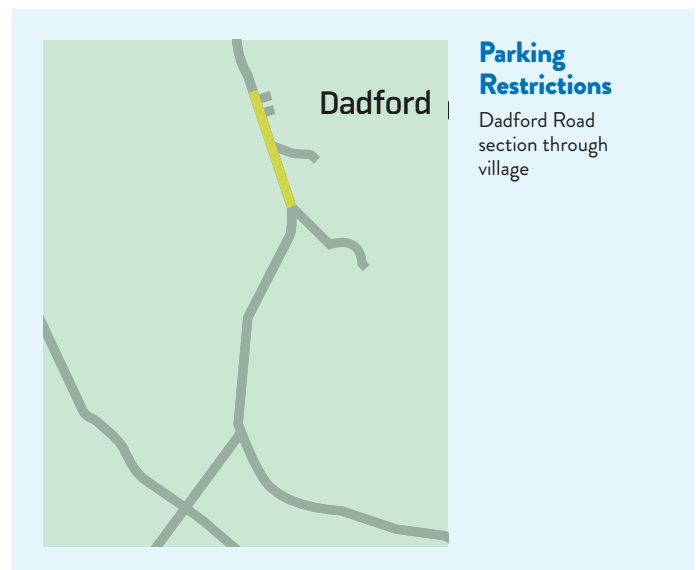
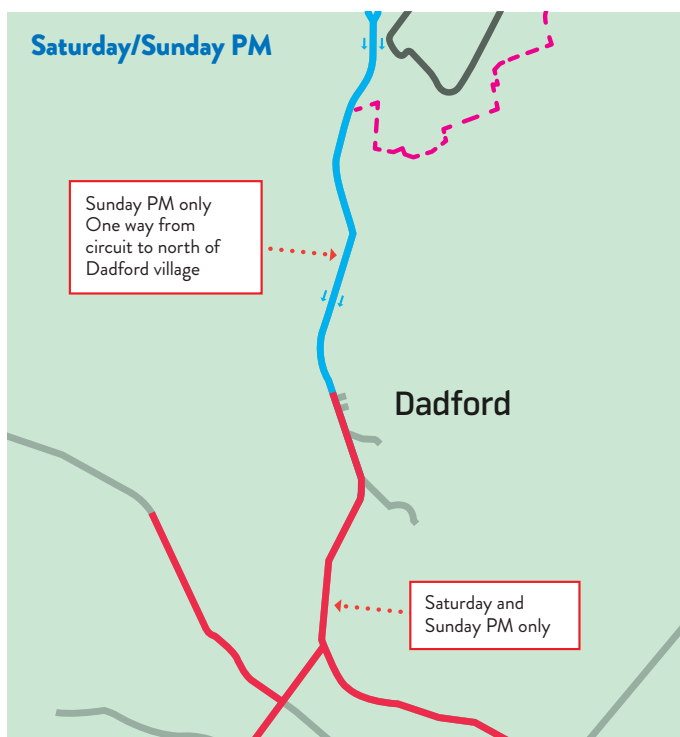
- Display Resident Access label for smooth entry/exit (only required for some routes)
- All routes available
- Avoid using Silverstone village due to local access restrictions



DADFORD

Saturday/Sunday AM

No road closures operating.



Getting in and out of Dadford village:

- Display **RESIDENT ACCESS** label for smooth entry.
- Exit and enter the village via Stowe crossroads on all event days (Friday – Sunday).

RESIDENTS' INCIDENT LOGGING SYSTEM – NEW

Wednesday 1 July – Monday 6 July

Use the QR code to provide information about any event-related incidents that may need to be actioned eg barrier fallen over in village, signage removed
Log the incident with this dedicated QR code



PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Active: Friday 3 July 00:01 – Sunday 5 July 23:59

- Applies across Silverstone, Whittlebury, and Dadford
- Roads marked with cones = **No parking at any time**
- Lay bys are **not included** and may be used
- West Northants Council enforcement officers will be patrolling

Blue Badge residents without off street parking. If you requested one, an exempt parking space should be near your property.

Crofts Stores 30 minute short stay parking in operation

RESIDENT ACCESS

- Display your resident access label when driving
- Labels help stewards guide you through closures where possible
- Labels do not allow parking in restricted roads
- Stewards can only allow access when safe – please be patient during busy periods
- When one way systems operate, residents must follow traffic flow

Important: There is **no vehicle access for residents** into Silverstone Village via Abthorpe Crossroads between **15:00–23:00** on Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 July. Use alternative route via **Whittlebury**

FOOTPATH & BRIDLEWAY CLOSURES

Thursday 2 July – Sunday 5 July:

- Limited closures for event safety and security
- Stewards will allow access for local residents (ID may be requested)

Wednesday 1 July – Monday 6 July:

- Woodlands campsite implement a full closure of footpath section across their land

POLICING

- The safety and security of local people, racegoers and all visitors to the area is a priority
- Northamptonshire Police will be conducting an extensive policing operation during the event to prevent crime and deal with incidents, both at the circuit and in the local community
- Uniformed and plain-clothed police officers will be on duty to patrol the circuit, campsites and local area
- They will be supported by local neighbourhood police officers and PCSOs to provide a community policing presence in surrounding villages
- As well as a large policing presence during the event, information and crime prevention advice will be shared online
- Information will be available at www.northants.police.uk and on social media to help ensure a safe and crime-free weekend for both local residents and visitors

NOISE

- Circuit evening concerts will operate within statutory noise regulations
- A full on site and off site noise monitoring programme for track and entertainment noise will operate from Thursday 2 July to Sunday 5 July
- Sounds checks take place from Wednesday 1st July
- The noise complaints procedure is detailed on the Residents' British Grand Prix information page of the circuit website
